Student Society Showcase Guidelines

Description: The ASHP Pharmacy Student Forum Student Society Showcase is a program for SSHPs to present one successful program, service, fundraiser, or activity during the ASHP Midyear Meeting. The Showcase is an opportunity to share ideas and information with fellow student pharmacists.

Participation: This event is open to all SSHPs. Submit the online application by November 1 to be able to participate. All Midyear attendees are welcome to attend. Consider inviting your classmates and faculty to attend the showcase.

Location: The Showcase will be conducted as part of the 2026 ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting & Exhibition. It will be located in the Poster Hall, located in West Hall C, Level 2.

Date/Time: The Showcase will be held on **Sunday, December 6, 2027, from 5:30 p.m.–6:30 p.m.** Booths will be available for set up from 11:30 a.m.– 3:00 p.m. Please arrive no later than 3:00 pm to set up your booth and ensure that all booths are ready for presentation when the showcase doors open.

Shipping of Showcase Materials: Individual societies are responsible for shipping their showcase materials. When sending items to hotels, we recommend calling the hotel to check for extra fees. Directly shipping to the convention center is not recommended due to the congestion of poster materials; this might result in challenges finding items, and there are handling charges for on-site locating. Properly label any containers with the society name and contact details regardless of transportation choice.

Security: The student society is fully responsible for its showcase materials and items, as ASHP is not liable for losses or damages.

Content of Individual Showcase Materials: The SSHP should highlight a single successful SSHP initiative from the prior academic year (2025-2026). The goal is to inspire other SSHPs to adopt and implement similar projects on their campuses in the future.

Share & Reapply Handout – Optional

A Share & Reapply Handout is optional. If you wish to share your handout for consideration for the ASHP website, you can submit it through the Showcase Application. A [sample share and reapply handout template](#) is available.

Additional Information/Tips: Prepare a "tool kit" for your meeting, including thumbtacks, pushpins, and any essential assembly items. You may bring colored cloth or paper for the background of your exhibit display. Tape, Velcro, or any other form of adhesive is *not* acceptable. Table-top exhibits are permitted. Using projection, demonstration, or sound equipment of any kind is prohibited. Opt for a shipping tube and/or case you can carry when transporting your materials. All exhibits must remain on display throughout the entire event. At least one representative from the student society must be present at the exhibit at all times. Exhibits left unattended will be taken down.

ASHP will provide the following for each Student Society Showcase exhibit:

- Standing poster board made of panels approximately 8 feet wide (2.4 meters) by 4 feet high (1.2 meters); total height is approximately 7 feet.
- 6-foot, skirted table in front of the standing poster board.
- Sign featuring the official name of the student society as submitted on the Showcase application form.
- ASHP staff monitors to assist Showcase exhibitors as required.

Schedule of the Student Society Showcase:

- 11:30 a.m.– 3:00 p.m.: Showcase Hall opens for exhibit set-up (all participants must have a Midyear 2026 Name badge)
 - **If you miss the set-up window, you can come to the poster hall at 5:15 p.m. to set up**
- 5:15 p.m.: Showcase doors open
- 5:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.: Student Society Showcase
- 6:30 p.m.: Showcase doors close; participants begin exhibit tear-down
- 6:30 p.m. – 6:45 p.m.: Tear-down of showcase materials
- 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.: Shuttle bus service for Student Society Showcase
